c. <u>Proposal:</u> Survey Results	Yes / No	
A. Reduce the assessment from \$475 to \$425/yr. starting 2025	34 / 4	
B. Road Fund minimum investment 45% (\$191.25/lot/yr.)	32 / 2	
C. Install a gazebo over cement pad at the tennis court park	32 / 5	

These proposals can be implemented by a majority vote of the Directors.

- Move to have Director's vote to implement all 3 proposals per the survey results above. Directors present approved unanimously.
